DIRECTIONS TO THE FESTIVAL

We're easy to find! The Niagara Power Vista is located on Lewiston Road (Route 104) in Lewiston, NY

From Buffalo & Points South: Take I-90 north to Exit 25A (Lewiston). Turn left onto Military Road (Route 265). Turn left onto Lewiston Road (Route 104 West). You will see a pedestrian overpass, turn left at the blinking yellow light.

From Lockport & Points East: Follow Route 104 West. You will see a pedestrian overpass, turn left at the blinking yellow traffic light. Or take Witmer Road (Route 31 West). Turn right onto Hyde Park Blvd. (Route 61) and follow until it ends onto Lewiston Road (Route 104 East). Turn right onto Lewiston Road and turn right at the blinking yellow traffic light.
