

We're Easy to Reach...

From the Metropolitan NYC area and South: Interstate 87 (NYS Thruway) north to Exit 21, Catskill; Route 23 west to Grand Gorge; to Route 30 north. Stay on Route 30 north for 8 miles. The visitors center will be on your right.

From Albany and East: Interstate 90 (NYS Thruway) west to Exit 25A, Schenectady; Interstate 88 west to Exit 23, Schoharie/Central Bridge; left on Route 30 south to North Blenheim. The visitors center is 2.5 miles south of the village on your left.

From Syracuse and West: Interstate 90 (NYS Thruway) east to Exit 29, Canajoharie; Route 5S east to Route 162; Route 30A south to Route 30 south to North Blenheim. The visitors center is 2.5 miles south of the village on your left.

... And Open Year Round. Our admission-free visitors center is open seven days a week year-round, except some holidays. Hours are 10 a.m. to 5 p.m.

Planning Your Visit: Why not schedule your trip around one of the many festivals and special events we host throughout the year? Check the front of this card for a calendar of upcoming events and educational programs. The center is open to the public and is handicapped-accessible. School groups and motor-coach groups are welcome.
